

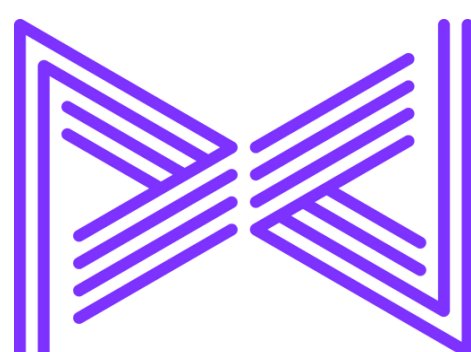

Give Me Space is a striking new dance piece co-created with ConfiCo.

Together, the dancers share their lived experience of disability, exploring what it feels like to live in a world that doesn't always listen or include.



Confidance are an inclusive dance company based in Kent.

We work in schools, in the community and professional training for **people with learning disabilities and neurodivergence.**

ConfiCo are Confidance's professional dance company.

Based in Folkestone, they train in contemporary dance technique and performance.

They have performed their work in lots of different venues such as theatres, schools, and outdoors.

What is it about?

Give Me Space is about the dancers' lived experiences of disability.

Through **movement** and **voiceovers**, we explore how it feels to be excluded by systems and rules that don't fit.

It is also about **strength, creativity** and the fight to be **heard and understood.**

The venue

The event will take place at Biggin Hall in Dover. Here is some information about the venue.



The performance will take place in a community hall called Biggin Hall.

The address is: **Biggin Hall, Biggin Street, Dover CT16 1BD**



There is a paid car park next to the venue, called **Ladywell car park**. There is off-street parking nearby.

Biggin Hall is a 7 minute walk from Dover Priory Train Station.



There is **an accessible toilet**. It does not have a hoist facility.

There are gender neutral toilets.



Our allocated quiet space at this venue is in an outside courtyard. You are welcome to take breaks in the outside area if you need during the performance.

Access overview



An **accessible programme** will be available to explain the performance.



You are welcome to **take breaks** whenever you need.



You can **stim, move or make noise** during the show.



The performances and closing party include **loud and energetic music**. Feel free to bring **ear defenders** if helpful.



There will be **no strobe lighting or full blackouts**. Sunglasses are welcome if that helps you feel comfortable.

Unfortunately these events **do not currently include BSL, live captioning or audio description**. This is something we want to develop for future performances.

The dance workshop will be a welcoming space for everyone to dance together.

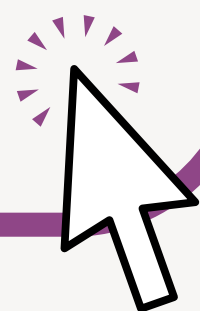
